Strategic Goal 1 - Responsive Curriculum and Pedagogy

To develop a curriculum that is responsive to the cultures, needs, interests, and aspirations of all ākonga while continuously growing professional capabilities and collective capacity across our school.

Annual Objectives

Curriculum Development

1. Mathematics Curriculum

- Strengthen consistency in structured mathematics teaching schoolwide.
- Implement targeted professional learning for teachers in structured mathematics.
- Ensure alignment of mathematics progressions with the refreshed curriculum.
- Utilise improved assessment tools to track student progress effectively.

2. Structured Literacy Approach

- Maintain and refine structured literacy implementation across all year levels.
- Continue monitoring literacy data through Pseudo word and LLLL assessments.

3. English Language Learners (ELL) Program

- Develop and implement a consistent schoolwide ELL support program.
- Utilise targeted specialist teachers for improving language acquisition and academic progress.

4. Student Achievement & Assessment

- Transition from eTap to Hero for school-wide assessment tracking.
 - Align assessment procedures with the refreshed curriculum and MoE guidelines.
 - Identify and extend high-achieving students, particularly Māori learners, through targeted enrichment opportunities.
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Strategic Goal 2 - Hauora

To build well-being and resilience in our community.

Annual Objectives

1. Student Attendance & Engagement

- Develop a plan to improve regular attendance, with a focus on Māori learners.
- Collaborate with whānau and external agencies to address barriers to attendance.
- Implement regular attendance tracking and reporting to ensure sustained improvement.

2. Park Way Values and Behavioural Expectations

- Reinforce the Park Way framework through visual displays, assemblies, and positive reinforcement strategies.
- Strengthen school-wide behaviour tracking and response systems.

Strategic Goal 3 - Learning Partnerships

To develop authentic learning partnerships with whānau and the wider community.

Annual Objectives

- 1. Whānau Engagement & Attendance Improvement**
 - Host targeted attendance-focused whānau hui to collaborate on strategies for improving school attendance.
 - Develop whānau engagement strategies aligned with school priorities.
- 2. Community Involvement & Events**
 - Continue school-wide events (Matariki celebrations, sports days, cultural showcases) with a focus on increasing Māori learner participation.
- 3. Digital and Social Media Awareness**
 - Organise annual digital safety and social media awareness sessions in collaboration with external experts.
 - Regularly update school communications to ensure families are informed and engaged.

Monitoring and Evaluation

- Attendance improvement reports every six months.
- Regular reviews on the effectiveness of structured mathematics delivery.
- Assessment of progress for high-achieving students, particularly Māori learners.
- Evaluation of ELL program impact on language acquisition and academic achievement.
