Dear Parents/Caregivers of Akomanga 27,

Welcome back to another school year! I hope you all enjoyed a nice, relaxing break with your children. My name is Grant Miller, and I have been lucky enough to meet quite a few of you already. I am very excited about working with the students in Room 27 this year, and I'm sure we will enjoy a wonderful year of learning together.

I have been teaching for 17 years, across various levels. This will be my twelfth year at Knighton Normal School and my third in the Year 5/6 team. I enjoy sports, the outdoors, and love animals. I live in Cambridge with my family, which includes my wife Angela, my 11 year old daughter, Harper, my 9-year-old son, Escher, our Labrador, Bailey, and our two cats, Cece and Locki.

In Term 1, we will be learning about 'Ourselves and our own personal journey'. #### Stationery

Alternatively, you can use one of the options suggested on the stationery notice.

#### Swimming and Library

The swimming days for Room 27 are Tuesday 11:35-11:55, and Thursday 12:15 -12:35. Please help your child to remember their togs and towel in a named bag on each of these days.

Library day is Monday; please ensure your child brings their book or books on this day. Library visits will start in Week 4 (23rd February).

#### Hats

**School hats** must be worn in Terms 1 and 4. If your child needs a new hat, one can be purchased from the school office for \$12. If your child does not have a school hat, they will only be able to play in the shade at break times.

### Medical Needs

Should your child need any medication during the school day, please visit our Office. You will be asked to fill in a permission form, and the medicine will be kept safely and administered when needed.
