The Plan for the Day

Group	Activity
Years 1-6	At 2pm all tamariki will go to the marae to engage in cultural workshops and learning.
Years 1-3	From 3pm, younger students are invited to stay for afternoon activities, provided they are accompanied by a parent or caregiver. 5pm they will perform for whānau followed by dinner.
Years 4-6	These students will remain at the marae for their overnight stay (noho).
