Create your own tiny magical world in a garden! Create your own tiny portal to a magical, mythical, or mysterious world!

Let your imagination run wild:

What lies behind the door?

Is it home to:

A wizard or a dragon?

A robot or alien?

A lost world of dinosaurs or candy?

Something entirely new that YOU invent?

What is a “Door to Another World”?

It’s a small, crafted doorway or entrance set in a decorated scene—like the base of a tree, wall, or rock—designed to spark curiosity about the world beyond it.

Who can enter?

Any Ōropi School student.

When & how?

- Calf Club Day: Friday 10 October
- Work on your portal over the school holidays
- Register online before the event
- Bring your finished scene to school by 10am for judging
- Clearly label it with your entry number

What can you use?

- Natural or recycled materials, paint, mini props, and decorations
- Your display should be no larger than 40cm x 40cm
- No electricity, glass, or sharp objects
- Make sure everything is sturdy and weather-resistant

Display Location:

All entries will be showcased on the day in a designated area of the school gully, creating a magical trail of portals for everyone to explore!

After the event:

You can take your portal home or donate it to remain in the gully as part of an ongoing magical display at Ōropi School.
