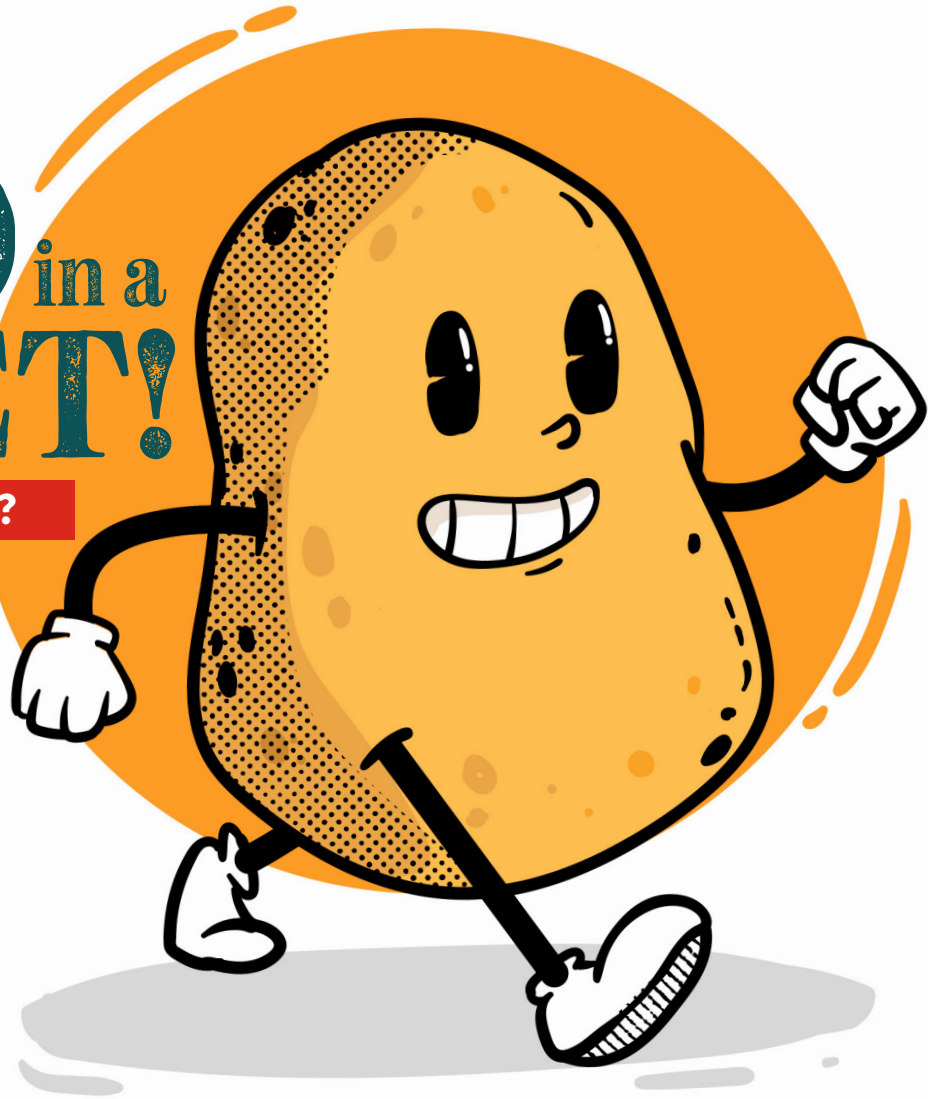

Potato Growing Competition

– Rules & Guidelines

To keep things fair (and fun!), please follow the rules below:

One bucket per child

Each participant may enter only one bucket in the competition.

Label your bucket clearly

Make sure your bucket is clearly labelled with your full name and class.

Official bucket and seed potato only

You must use the seed potato and bucket supplied by the school. No other buckets or potatoes will be accepted.

Use your own mix

You'll need to provide your own potting mix, soil, or compost. Get creative and try to out-grow the competition!

Bring your planted bucket on Calf Club Day

Your potato plant must be brought to the event in its bucket, fully planted. Loose potatoes or unplanted entries will not be judged.

Judging discretion

All judging decisions are final and made at the discretion of the judge.
