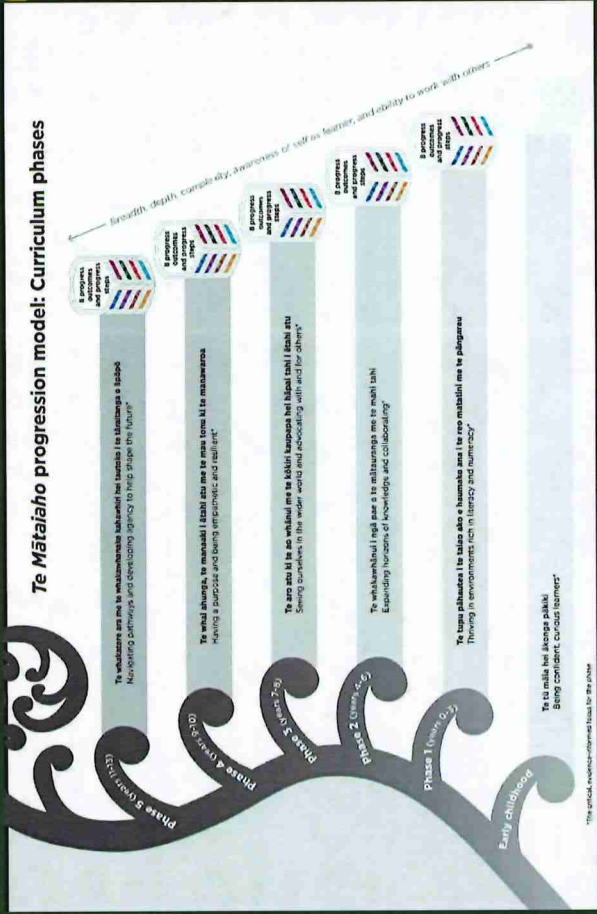
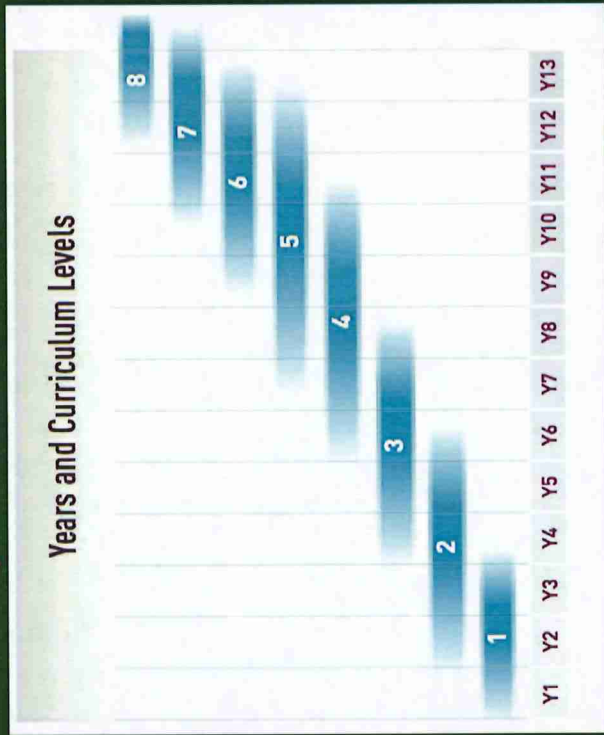
# Timeline

- **Term 1, 2025:** Schools and kura must **teach** the updated English curriculum for Years 0 to 6, and maths and pāngarau for Years 0 to 8.
- **Term 1, 2026:** Schools and kura with Years 7 to 13 must teach the updated English curriculum and mathematics and statistics and pāngarau for Years 9 to 13.

The fully updated national curriculum, including all the other learning areas, other subjects, will be available for all schools and kura to use throughout 2026, giving a full year of implementation support before it's officially required from 2027.

# New Learning Phases

To align with the refreshed curriculum, our teams are structured as:

- ◆ Phase 1 - Year 0-3 - 8 progress outcomes
- ◆ Phase 2 - Year 4-6
- ◆ Phase 3 - Year 7-8

There are 5 phases of the curriculum.

## How We Are Supporting Students

- ◆ Teaching tailored to meet students where they are within year levels
- ◆ Key programs (e.g. Garden to Table ) will continue
- ◆ Leadership opportunities for Year 5-8 students
- ◆ **Our goal:** A clear, structured learning journey for every child through HERO

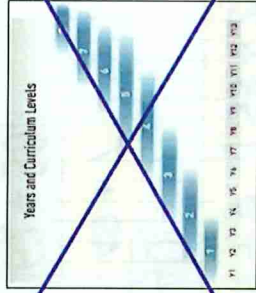
Learning stories will still be feature of reporting to parents on all other curriculum areas.

# What's Changing

- **Focus on progression & growth** across year levels  
Each phase takes **around 3 years** to complete
- **Assessment tracks progress** within phases.
- **A curriculum** that is based on time at school not classification. Such as **Within the 1st 6 months - Within 1 Year etc...**

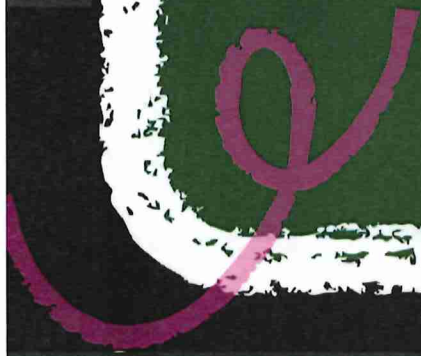




