Claiming your prizes

Prize ordering opens on 14th March and closes on 21st March.

After the event please log on to your account at School Fundraising (details on front cover) and click 'Order Prizes' and follow the prompts.

Please note: If you have selected a goal prize, you still need to log on to order your prizes

How to save the colour in your Colour Run t-shirt

Once you have returned home and removed your t-shirt, lay the shirt on a flat surface. (Pro tip: if you lay the shirt on a moveable piece of cardboard, a towel, or newspaper, there will be less clean-up.) Once the shirt is lying flat, spray it with white vinegar until it is completely soaked. Keep in mind that as the colour powder becomes wet it will spread out and stain the surrounding area.

Let it Dry

Once your shirt is nice and soaked through, leave it somewhere to dry. Make sure to keep the shirt flat as this will prevent the colours from meshing together even more.

Iron the Dry Shirt

In order to fully set the colours into place, you will need to apply heat to them. To do this, we recommend ironing the shirt once it is completely dry. Because the iron can steam and cause the colour run t-shirt to become damp, we recommend turning the shirt inside out and placing a towel between the iron and the shirt.

Toss Your Color Run T-Shirt in the Dryer

Once you have ironed the shirt, toss it in the dryer! This will lock the colours into place, even more, ensuring that your shirt will remain colourful and unique for the rest of its life. (Please note: colours can fade with each wash, but they will not go away completely.)

Friday 14th March—Albany Primary School Colour Run

About the day:

- The event is public – we are aware that parents will attend as spectators and are welcome to take photos. Under our school policy APS expects our school community to consider privacy when sharing someone else's personal information. This includes taking recordings at school or school-related events or activities, and sharing this content.
- Friday will be a non-uniform day. We request that students wear light coloured shirts so the colour can be seen, and shorts or something comfortable to complete the obstacle course in and a hat, on the understanding that these clothes will get colour powder on them. We would recommend that you bring a plastic bag and towel in your car for easy clean up when transporting your child home. If your child forgets to bring a spare hat with them then please be aware that they will use their school hat.
- All bus students will require a spare set of clothes for them to change into in order to catch the bus home. As well as their change of clothes, these students will also need a plastic bag and towel in their school bag.
- Lunch eating and play will be at an earlier time of 12.20pm-1.00pm.
- The colour run will commence at 1.00pm on our school fields. All classes will participate. Approximate times: Senior classes will run from 1.00pm-1.30pm, junior 1.30pm-2.00pm and middle school 2.00pm-2.30pm.
- Thank you to our parent volunteers—please attend a health and safety briefing on the day at 12.30pm in the school office.

Special notes:

- If you do not want to participate in the fundraising – your child is still able to attend the Colour Run.
- If you want to participate in the fundraising but do not want your child to participate in the Colour Run please email your child's classroom teacher and they will support on the sidelines.
- If you want your child to participate but do not want them to be sprayed with colour please email your child's classroom teacher and your child will wear a band when running so our sprayers are aware. Please note that despite our best intentions, there may still be a chance that they receive some colour overspray.
